

Michail Okoliyski obtained his Ph.D. in Rehabilitation Science and Master degree in Social Therapy, specialty Sexology from the Humboldt University in Berlin, Germany. Before joining the WHO in 2014 he worked as Associated Professor leading the Department “Mental health” at the National Centre of Public Health and Analyses, Ministry of Health in Sofia, Bulgaria. He was member of the Expert Group of governmental experts in mental health, DG SANCO, EC .
